OUTREACH

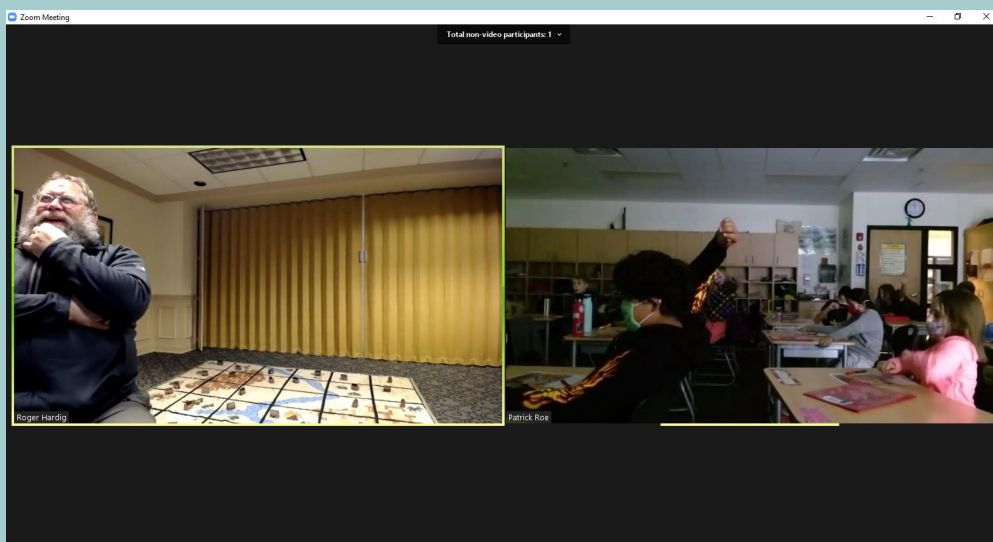
- We were fortunate to have over 19,000 onsite and live remote visitors from 25 different states, even though we were closed for nearly 4 months of the year!
- We had nearly 3,000 hours from 51 volunteers (including 2 new volunteers that we added in 2020). This is a cost savings of \$81,600.
- The Benjamin Harrison Presidential Site continued to generate interest near and far for our innovative programs and intentional leadership.
- We were featured in 5 national news stories, 9 regional stories, and 101 local stories, and even international acclaim for encouraging museums to serve as voter centers for their communities.



EDUCATION

Virtual and hybrid education became the norm in 2020 and we were ready to help with education programs, live virtual tours and 3D sources. From September to December, we served over 2000 students in live streamed educational programs and tours.

We also expanded programming with a fully funded national initiative to include a project-based learning model, and expanded our footprint with partnerships in the Future Presidents of America national outreach initiative.



We also expanded online resources, developing a committed Canvas page for Education resources.

CIVIC SERVICE

Due to public health guidelines, we were unable to be a voting center for the May primary, but that didn't stop us from providing our signature "I Voted" stickers curbside, and encouraging participation in the rescheduled June primary.

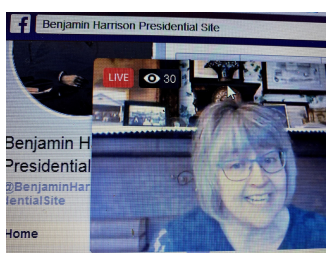

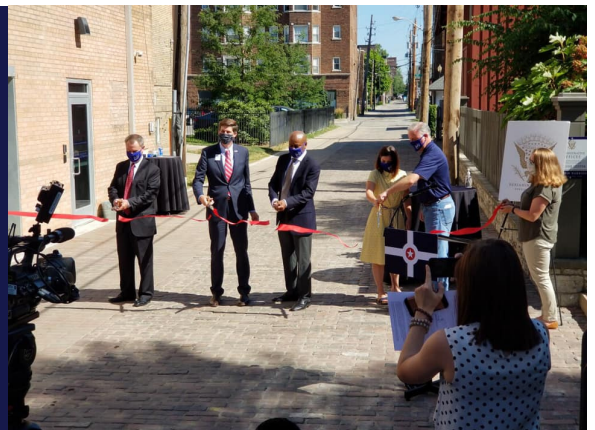
