Volunteer to review 60-90 second video projects about the American presidents from middle school or high school students all over the U.S as part of the Project POTUS contest in Spring 2026.

The Citizen Juror's Role:

- Estimated Time Commitment: 2 hours or less
- Online only role; Micro volunteer opportunity
- Jurors will be assigned 'caseload' of up to 30 (60-second or 90 second) videos to review
- Judging will take place online over the course of 2 weeks in March 2026, and is asynchronous - jurors can self-select a preferred time to review the assigned caseload within the open judging window
- Option to review an additional caseload for those interested
- Citizen Juror instructions, the Project POTUS submission scorecard, and the official calendar for judging will be sent to jurors in December 2025.
